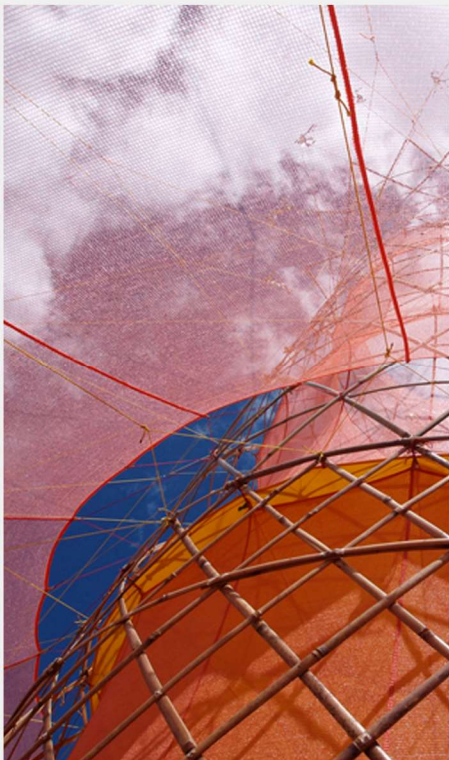

Rules & Regulations

1. Rules and Regulations of International Competition Laka Competition 2016: "Architecture that Reacts"

Article 1 General Information

1. "Architecture that Reacts" competition is organized on terms and conditions specified by these Rules and Regulations and in pursuance of applicable provisions of the Polish law.
2. The "Architecture that Reacts" competition is organised by Laka Architektura; EU VAT No. PL6381733612; REGON No. 361404054 (hereinafter referred to as: Organizer).
3. The competition objective is to promote the issue of "architecture that reacts", meant as a set of programme, spatial, technological and other features enabling dynamic architecture adjustment to current needs and circumstances. A description of "architecture that reacts" notion can be found on the competition website and in the competition "Brief".
4. The competition is addressed both to professionals focused on design and education activities, and people with a passionate interest in architecture not bound to any of the disciplines mentioned. Participation is not conditional on possessing design-related professional skills.
5. The competition will be joined by authors of projects submitted to the competition (hereinafter referred to as Participants). Underage persons must apply through their legal guardians.
6. The competition projects may be submitted both by individual participants and by interdisciplinary teams whose member amount is unlimited. Should applications for participation be made by teams composed of underage persons, a team leader must be of age.

On registration to the competition, teams indicate one person, a team representative to become a contact person with organisers in all issues related to the competition participation.

7. The Organizer's relatives, employees, as well as Jury Members, persons involved in competition organisation and their relatives and employees cannot become Participants.

Article 2 Competition regulations

1. The whole Competition will be in English.
2. Participants registration and submitting competition projects will be made online:
<http://www.lakareacts.com>
3. In order to take part, the Participants pay a registration fee of 50 USD ("early registration") or 75 USD ("regular registration") or 100 USD ("late registration"), depending on the registration date (according to the information on the competition website), via PayPal to the competition profile. Except a situation mentioned in item 5 below and in case of a Participant who is not accepted to take part due to formal reasons, the registration fees are non-refundable.
4. Registration opens on 1 April 2016 (UTC) and its deadline is 1 November 2016 (UTC).

5. Should less than 50 registrations be made in the period specified above, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel the Competition. In this case, the registration fees transferred will be refunded to the Participants PayPal profiles.

6. Upon receipt of registration fee payment, the competition Organizer will send an invitation to submit a project and the registration number to each Participant; the registration number is the only form of Participants' identification used by them since that moment till the Competition resolution. Signing the project otherwise than with the registration number, will disqualify a Participant.

7. Detailed scope of a project and its format have been defined in a "Brief" available on the Competition website.

8. An individual project may be registered only once. If a Participant enters more than one project, each has to be registered and paid with a registration fee separately.

9. This is a one-stage competition.

10. Participation terms and conditions:

- acceptance of these Rules and Regulations,
- submitting a project is equivalent to making a declaration on possessing copyright to the project,
- consent to personal data processing for the competition purposes,
- consent to publish the entered project on sub websites of: <http://www.lakareacts.com> and in post-competition publications.

11. The Organizer declares that any personal information of the Laka Competition Participant, including: first names and surnames of team members, their nationality, contact details, such as e-mail addresses, phone numbers can be processed by the Organizer to perform the competition.

The Organizer guarantees the Participants' right to access and correct their personal information, and request cessation of the information processing by the Organizer. The Participants' personal information will not be made available to any third party (with the exception of the situation described in 10). Participation in the Laka Competition and receiving an award is conditioned on providing personal information.

12. Project submission deadline is on 1 November 2016 (UTC). Projects submitted after that date will not participate. Registration fees registered after deadline for registration will be refunded.

13. Participants may submit their inquiries related to the course of competition and information included in the Rules and Regulations, to the e-mail address: hello@lakareacts.com. The Organizer will reply in the form of FAQ list made available on the competition website.

14. The Competition results will be announced on 1 December 2016 (UTC).

Article 3 Award Giving Rules

1. The projects submitted will be assessed by Jury chosen by the Organizer and composed of members listed on the competition website.

2. The Jury will assess the projects based on the criteria specified in the "Brief" on the competition website.

3. In the duration of the competition, the Participants should not contact the Jury members in any way.

4. The Jury decision will be final.

5. Awards have been specified in the competition "Brief" and on the competition website. The Organizer shall reserve the right to increase the financial awards value.

6. Winners announcement will be published on <http://www.lakareacts.com>

7. Additionally, the winners shall be notified by e-mail. Cash awards will be transferred to the winners' bank accounts. The Organizer will contact the winners by e-mail (given at the registration) to obtain bank account and its holder details, indispensable for making payment. The Organizer reserves the right to withdraw from award payment to the Participant who do not provide information required to make a wire transfer within a month of the Organizer request for this information.

8. The awarded and honoured projects will be published on the Competition website, on media partners websites and other printed and the Internet publications interested in publishing of the Competition results.

9. The Organizer provides for realization of periodic post-competition publications, in the form of leaflets, magazines, books and albums among other things, involving selected projects sent for the Competition.

10. Participants hereby declare that should their project be awarded or honoured, they grant the Organizer a free license to the Competition project (work) with no time or territorial restrictions, in the following fields of operation:

- making copies of the work in specific technique, including printing, reprographic, magnetic recording and digital techniques;
- marketing, lending or rental of the work original or copies;
- public display, presentation, reproduction and making the work available to the public in the method everyone can access it at a place and time of their choice;
- using the work and its fragments for the Organizer's promotion and advertising needs and his publications, in the form of press, TV, cinema, external and the Internet advertising, on any websites and domains as well as mobile services, in promotional and advertising materials and items and other forms of promotion in the fields of operation indicated above;
- exercising derivative copyright to the work (disposing of and using the work development), in the fields of operation indicated above.

Granting a license to the Organizer will in any way deprive the Participants of their right to dispose of the work and its copyright to other persons.

11. All authors of the sent projects retain their full moral rights (projects used in post-competition publications will bear their authors' names and surnames). Should a necessity of the sent projects modification in post-competition publications occur, the Organizer will apply for a modification consent to the project authors.
